

Magic Numbers Piecing – Take Two

We will be making 9 squares that finish to 12" each. By sewing these 9 squares together, you can make a nice baby quilt or lap quilt that measures 36.5" x 36.5". You may use 6 fat quarters or scraps. A diagram for cutting the fat quarters is below. Please use the following measurements to cut your fat quarters. If you prefer to use scraps, please cut the total number of pieces in the sizes as described below. There will be a few extras. If you'd like to have more variety, feel free to add a 7th fat quarter. Please bring the usual sewing supplies – sewing machine, thread, straight pins, safety pins, etc. A small iron and mat would be useful.

Depending on how the time goes, you may have your 9 squares sewn together by noon or so. Please bring a piece for backing at least 40" long, a similarly sized piece of batting, and safety pins. Various quilting designs will be discussed and you may have time to quilt it. If you'd like to make your project into a guild donation quilt, guild batting will be used and we can cut it from the roll at the church.

Please bring a lunch and drinks. A snack or dessert to share would be nice, but not required!

From each fat quarter, cut the following:

A – (4) 6.5" x 6.5" for a total of 24

B – (3) 4.5" x 4.5" for a total of 18

C – (6) 2.5" x 2.5" for a total of 36

D – (3) 4.5" x 2.5" for a total of 18

E – (3) 6.5" x 2.5" for a total of 18
