

Confetti Quilting for PBTB June 23, 2026, Setup 9 am, Class 9:30 am to 3 pm

To learn the confetti quilting technique, we will make a simple landscape wall hanging.

Supplies needed:

3 fat quarters

1 for backing

1 for facing (I like mine to match the backing) we will cut these in class

1 for the quilt top...now, this can be completely neutral, or it can be the color of the background of your landscape

Batik fabric (I like these due to their tight weave that minimizes fraying and the dye process that make “front & back” of fabric irrelevant.) Scraps and/or jellyrolls, pre-cuts, etc will work. We will be making a landscape with a field, tree, and sky, so you can go with total representation of traditional colors or go completely off script and do it all in one color with lots of different values.

Batting the size of 1 fat quarter

Regular sewing supplies

Rotary cutter with a new blade

Cutting mat for your work area

Sewing Machine (you can use free motion options or not...works either way)

Walking foot and/or quilting foot

Thread to match or complement your fabrics

Pins (straight & safety)

Basting spray if you have it
